

Fabrics: Cotton, cotton blends. *Back all fabrics with Heat 'n Bond Lite, Wonder Under or Steam a Seam 2 prior to placement on the applique.*


Banner 4A and Rope 4



Use when you have only a 4x4" hoop. Requires 2 hoopings.

Print true-size templates from your embroidery software. Place on your project. Position the rope so it overlaps the right end of the banner. Mark the vertical and horizontal centers. **Hoop the project** with the **Banner** markings centered.






Load **Banner4** into the machine.

	Color	Directions
1	1 – Blue	Stitch Color #1 , the banner placement. 
2	Match project	Stitch Color #2 , the optional underlay. <i>Stitch only on terry towels or fabric with loft (velour, etc).</i>
3A	Remove the hoop from the machine, placing it FACE UP on a flat surface.	

3B	Place the BANNER (A), RIGHT SIDE UP over the appropriate placement lines. Tape or pin corners to hold in place.		
3C	1 – Blue	Return the hoop to the machine. Stitch Color #3 , tacking down the banner.	
4A	Remove the hoop from the machine, placing it FACE UP on a flat surface.		
4B	Trim the banner close to the outer stitching lines.		
4C	Use a small craft iron to adhere the banner.		
4E	1 – Blue	Return the hoop to the machine. Stitch Color #4 , the banner.	
Remove the project from the hoop. Rehoop with the markings for the rope centered.			
Load Rope4 into the machine.			
1	2 - Yellow	Stitch Color #1 , the rope.	

Banner 4B & Banner 7

Load **Banner4B or Banner7** into the machine.

	Color	Directions
1	1 – Blue	Stitch Color #1 , placement lines for the design. 
2	Match project	Stitch Color #2 , the optional underlay. <i>Stitch only on terry towels or fabric with loft (velour, etc).</i>
3A	Remove the hoop from the machine, placing it FACE UP on a flat surface.	
3B	Place the BANNER (A) , RIGHT SIDE UP over the appropriate placement lines. Tape or pin corners to hold in place.	
3C	3 – Gray	Return the hoop to the machine. Stitch Color #3 , tacking down the vehicle body.
4A	Remove the hoop from the machine, placing it FACE UP on a flat surface.	
4B	Trim the banner close to the outer stitching lines.	
4C	Use a small craft iron to adhere the banner.	
4E	1 – Blue	Return the hoop to the machine. Stitch Color #4 , the banner.
5	2 – Yellow	Stitch Color #5 , the rope.

SVG/FCM files		
Check measurements of combined multiple pieces before splitting apart.		
The following are the true-size measurements. You will need to add an inflation value (shadow/offset) before cutting the fabric for the applique. The satin stitch is 3mm wide, so I suggest starting at 1.4mm extra around each piece. Adjust as needed.

Banner	93.4 x 56.02mm 3.68 x 2.21"	139.18 x 83.48mm 5.48 x 3.29"
If the pieces do not come into your cutting software at true size, try the alternate file Banner*_72 . Silhouette and Cricut seem to like it better.		

Combine with the Plane, part of the Up, Up, and Away Set. Stitch the plane first, then the banner/rope. *Personalize the banner with a name or monogram.*
