

**Fabrics:** Cotton, cotton blends. *Back all fabrics with Heat 'n Bond Lite, Wonder Under or Steam a Seam 2 prior to placement on the applique.*

<b>Garage</b>		
Load <b>Garage4</b> or <b>Garage7</b> into the machine.		
	<b>Color</b>	<b>Directions</b>
<b>1</b>	<b>1 – Pink</b>	<b>Stitch Color #1</b> , placement lines for the design. 
<b>2</b>	Match project	<b>Stitch Color #2</b> , the optional underlay. <i>Stitch only on terry towels or fabric with loft (velour, etc).</i>
<b>3A</b>	Remove the hoop from the machine, placing it <b>FACE UP</b> on a flat surface.	
<b>3B</b>	Place the <b>BUILDING (A)</b> , <b>RIGHT SIDE UP</b> over the appropriate placement lines.  Tape or pin corners in place. 	
<b>3C</b>	<b>1 – Pink</b>	Return the hoop to the machine. <b>Stitch Color #3</b> , tacking down the building and sewing the placement for the sign and pump.
<b>4A</b>	Remove the hoop from the machine, placing it <b>FACE UP</b> on a flat surface.	

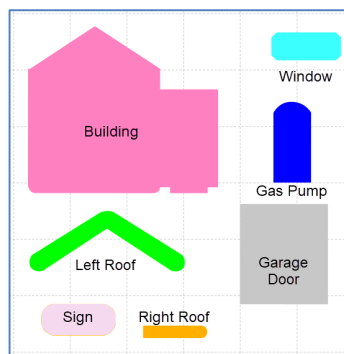
4B	Trim the building close to the outer stitching lines.		
4C	Use a small craft iron to adhere the building.		
4D	Place the <b>SIGN (B)</b> and <b>RIGHT ROOF (C)</b> <b>RIGHT SIDE UP</b> over the appropriate placement lines.  Tape or pin corners to hold in place.		
4E	2 – Orange Yellow	Return the hoop to the machine. <b>Stitch Color #4</b> , tacking down the sign and the right roof.	
5A	Remove the hoop from the machine, placing it <b>FACE UP</b> on a flat surface.		
5B	Trim the sign and the right roof close to the outer stitching lines.		
5C	Use a small craft iron to adhere the sign and the right roof.		

5D		<p>Place the <b>GAS PUMP (D)</b>, <b>RIGHT SIDE UP</b> over the appropriate placement lines.</p> <p>Tape corners or use a small dab of washable glue stick to hold in place.</p> 
5E	<b>3 – Bright Blue</b>	Return the hoop to the machine. <b>Stitch Color #5</b> , tacking down the gas pump.
6A		Remove the hoop from the machine, placing it <b>FACE UP</b> on a flat surface.
6B		<p>Trim the gas pump close to the outer stitching lines.</p> 
6C		Use a small craft iron to adhere the gas pump.
6D		<p>Place the <b>LEFT ROOF (E)</b>, <b>RIGHT SIDE UP</b> over the appropriate placement lines.</p> <p>Tape corners or use small dabs of washable glue stick to hold in place.</p> 
6E	<b>4 - Lime</b>	Return the hoop to the machine. <b>Stitch Color #6</b> , tacking down the left roof.
7A		Remove the hoop from the machine, placing it <b>FACE UP</b> on a flat surface.

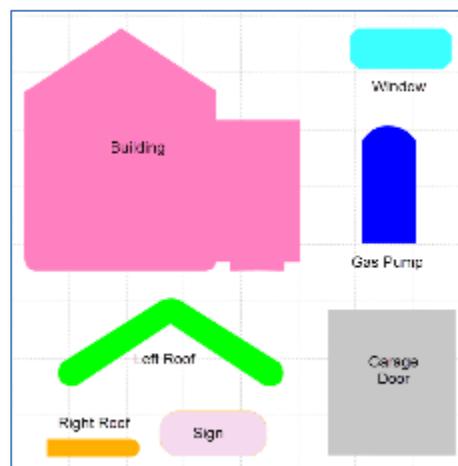
7B	Trim the left roof close to the outer stitching lines.		
7C	Use a small craft iron to adhere the left roof.		
7D	Place the <b>GARAGE DOOR (F), RIGHT SIDE UP</b> over the appropriate placement lines.  Tape corners or use small dabs of washable glue stick to hold in place.		
7E	5 – White	Return the hoop to the machine. <b>Stitch Color #7</b> , tacking down the garage door and stitching the placement lines for the window.	
8A	Remove the hoop from the machine, placing it <b>FACE UP</b> on a flat surface.		
8B	Trim the garage door close to the outer stitching lines.		
8C	Use a small craft iron to adhere the garage door.		

8D		<p>Place the <b>WINDOW (G)</b>, <b>RIGHT SIDE UP</b> over the appropriate placement lines.</p> <p>Tape corners or use a small dab of washable glue stick to hold in place</p> 
8E	5 – White	Return the hoop to the machine. <b>Stitch Color #8</b> , tacking down the window.
9A		Remove the hoop from the machine, placing it <b>FACE UP</b> on a flat surface.
9B		<p>Trim the window close to the outer stitching lines.</p> 
9C		Use a small craft iron to adhere the window.
9D	1 – Pink	Return the hoop to the machine. <b>Stitch Color #9</b> , the right side of the building.
10	2 – Orange Yellow	<b>Stitch Color #10</b> , the sign, and the right roof.
11	3 – Bright Blue	<b>Stitch Color #11</b> , the gas pump
12	1 – Pink	<b>Stitch Color #12</b> , the left side of the building.
13	6 – Gray	<b>Stitch Color #13</b> , the door handle, pump fixtures, and the chimney.
14	4 – Lime	<b>Stitch Color #14</b> , the left roof.
15	5 – White	<b>Stitch Color #15</b> , the garage door and gas pump window.
16	7 – Black	<b>Stitch Color #16</b> , the trim on the gas pump window, the pump lettering, and the hose.
17	7 – Black	<b>Stitch Color #17</b> , the lettering on the sign. <i>I left this as a separate color so you could change it easily.</i>

SVG/FCM files		
Check measurements of combined multiple pieces before splitting apart.		
The following are the true-size measurements. You will need to add an inflation value (shadow/offset) before cutting the fabric for the applique. The satin stitch is 3mm wide, so I suggest starting at 1.4mm extra around each piece. Adjust as needed.

If the pieces do not come into your cutting software at true size, try the alternate file <b>Garage*_72</b> . Silhouette and Cricut seem to like it better.
